"The Spirit told me to have no hesitation about going with them." - Acts 11:12a

Recently my son Theodore brought home a Valentine's Day list of students and teachers in his class. It described how they will be celebrating Valentine's Day and what kind of gifts work best for that day. It struck me that in my son's public school classroom they will be celebrating a Christian holiday. Although the details of St. Valentine's life are debated, there is no debate that he existed and that every year on February 14th we celebrate love.

You might not see that as a big deal - a public school celebrating a Christian holiday - but I do. I don't see it as a big deal because some might consider it a breakdown of the so called "separation of church and state." No. It's a big deal because it's a day where our entire country celebrates love. And God is love! And we are a faith community based on love! What an opportunity to share the truest love of all, the love of Jesus, with everyone around us!

Now I know, you're probably thinking "that's a bit of a stretch Pastor Paul", but that's the point. Our next sermon series is about stretching a bit. Stretching our missional muscles to be a little more neighborly, a little more evangelistic, a little more open to the movement of the Spirit. It's entitled "Joining Jesus on His Mission" and it's focused on a particularly forgotten understanding of mission - that Jesus is already in your neighborhood, through the power of the Holy Spirit, doing the work of preparing people's hearts and minds for a little love from you. You and I aren't the heavy lifters when it comes to changing our world - God is.

This is what the verse at the beginning of this article is all about. The apostle Peter hadn't quite realized that Jesus was already on the move outside of the borders of Jerusalem and the tiny Christian community there. Not only was Jesus already working outside of that band of believers through the power of the Holy Spirit, he was working in the lives of Gentiles, Romans, pagans - unbelievers (deep gasp)! When Peter finally understood what the Holy Spirit was up to, he reported back to the Jewish Christians in Jerusalem that he indeed went to the house of Cornelius and that indeed the Holy Spirit had gone before him.

The Holy Spirit is going before us today as well! If we are willing to open our eyes and see what Peter saw, we too will have no hesitation to go across the street, down the hallway, across town, or wherever God is sending us to share the good news. The opportunities are there if we remember who's already there!

Which brings me back to Valentine's Day. Valentine's Day is an opportunity. Really. What other day do Christians get to freely and without excuse celebrate what our faith is based on: love!? Consider it a day with no hesitation. And go freely to your neighbor with the love of Jesus.

CELEBRATING CHRISTMAS





Consider this: in 2019 we had 2,400 people attend worship at Christmas with almost zero online presence.

This year we estimate that over 4,000 people saw and heard the Christmas story through The Living Story, we had **over 800 people attend** in-person worship on Christmas Eve and **over 1,000 views** of our Christmas service online - and who knows how many people were viewing at a time.

When you put it all together, in 2019 we shared the Christmas story with 2400 people the week of Christmas. In 2020, that number exceeded 6,000 people. (Wow!)

ANNUAL CELEBRATION RECAP | JANUARY 31, 2021

On January 31 we met for our Annual Celebration (also known as the Annual Meeting.)

We joined in-person and online to review how God worked in 2020 and prepared our focus for 2021. We are SO thankful for technology - especially in lowa during the winter. With the hard work of our staff, the patience of the congregation, and the power of technology, we were able to host our first hybrid Annual Celebration.

We had about 30 people in attendance, as well as 70+ people on Zoom that were able to participate in the meeting. It went about as well as it could - even when Jason

Christensen kept interrupting Pastor Paul and breaking into song!

Jason Freeman, the outgoing church Council President presented a report, as did Pastor Paul. Pam Schulz, Executive Director, and Cheri Presley, Finance Manager, presented the financials for 2020 and 2021. Lois Mulbrook led us through nominating new members for church council, the nominating committee, and St. Mark's Foundation. Finally, we did vote regarding the sale of 3.55 acres to the city of Cedar Rapids for the upcoming Tower Terrace Road project.

We've had over 200 people download the Church Center mobile app since January 1, 2021!






