



THE DIVINE DRAMA

On Wednesday, August 25 at 12:00 pm we will begin a 16-week journey through God's word. Pastor Steve will lead our study using the Crossways International course entitled "The Divine Drama."

This intensive 60-minute per week course will focus on the Bible and applying the teachings of Jesus in our lives through a deeper study of the Old and New Testament, the problem of sin, God's never-failing promises, and His work to make all things right through His beloved son, Jesus the Messiah. The Master's Institute is a seminary that equips the heart, head, and hands of servant leaders to continue the ministry of Jesus through the power of the Holy Spirit through spiritual and character formation, Biblical teaching, and leadership training.

The Micro-MDiv is an 18-month leadership training program focused on increasing the competency, character, and capacity of Christian leaders so they can optimize their calling in God's kingdom. The Micro-MDiv combines eighteen masters level courses with weekly spiritual/character formation, spiritual mentoring, monthly scripture practicum exercises and a formal leadership development process into a vital, accessible, Jesus-focused program.



ALPHA

ALPHA IS FOR ANYONE. The Alpha course provides an opportunity to ask questions and explore the Christian faith in a relaxed setting. It covers the basics of Christianity and answers questions like "Who is Jesus?" and "Why did he die?" It's a 12-week series, including a weekend retreat where anyone can explore the Christian Faith in a friendly, open and informal environment.

Each session includes refreshments and a discussion on how Christianity approaches the question at hand, followed by a small group discussion where you can share your thoughts and questions in a relaxed setting.
