BONUS: Interpretation involves "_____", not "_____" Joseph indicates that he has a special God-given ability. The Hebrew terms for "interpretation" (*pitron*) and "interpret" (*patar*) occur only in Genesis 40-41 in the OT.

- 12. What's the (Hebrew) limit on the period of impaling (Deut. 21:22-23 and Joshua 10:26-27)?
